

Phase 3 Highways Work Programme Update August 2024

Windy Corner Highways Works (Phases 3)

The Windy Corner works will commence on Monday 16th September 2024. They are programmed to complete by Christmas 2024.

Persimmon have appointed Roadform Ltd to undertake the works and will endeavour to complete the works early but are reliant on the weather being favourable.

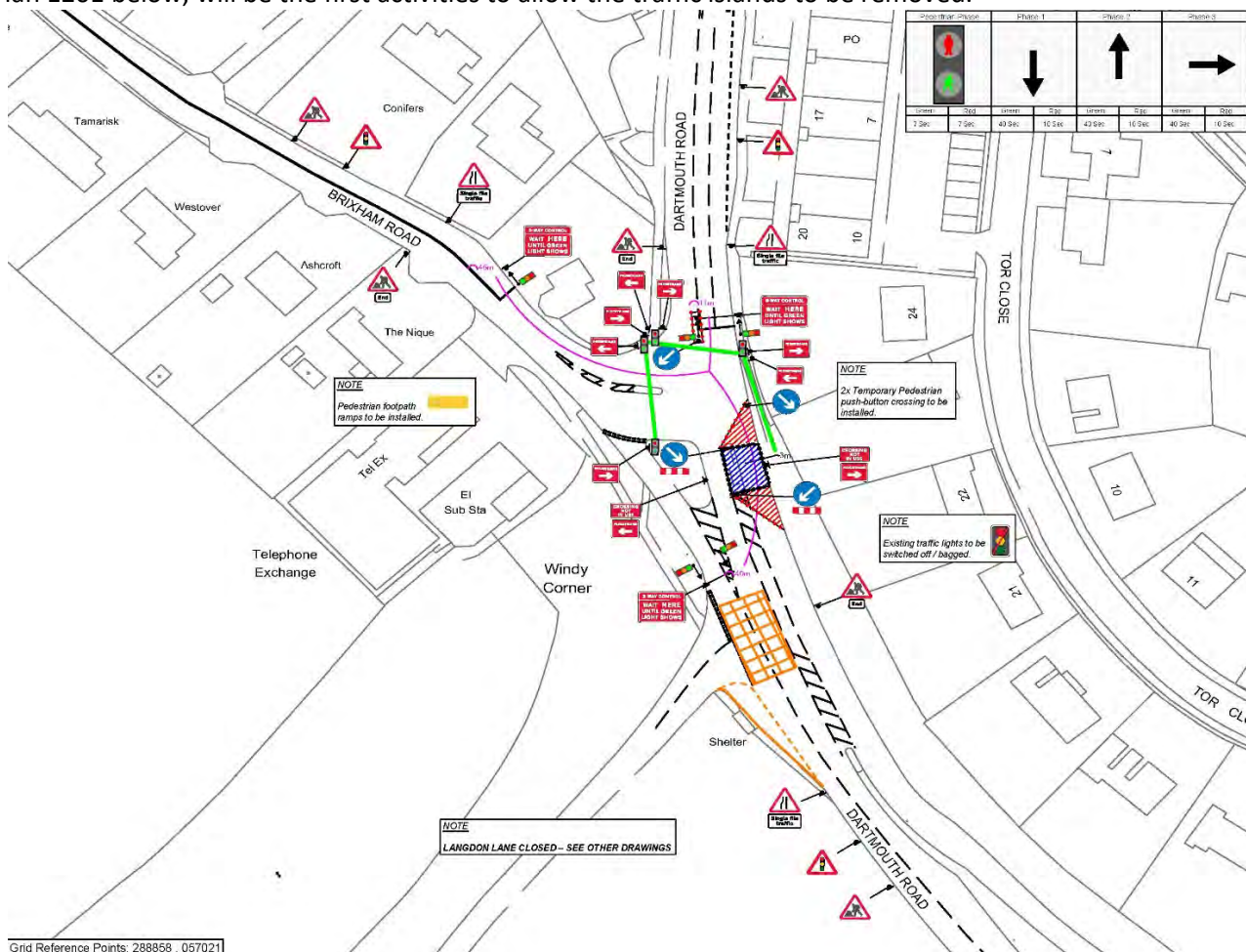
The Dartmouth Road and Brixham Road will remain open at all times. All works will be undertaken under traffic management.

The sequence of work is to start with the removal of the traffic islands and therefore for the duration of the works the Windy Corner junction will be under temporary lights. At times they will be run on a 3 way light and others on a 4 way light sequence.

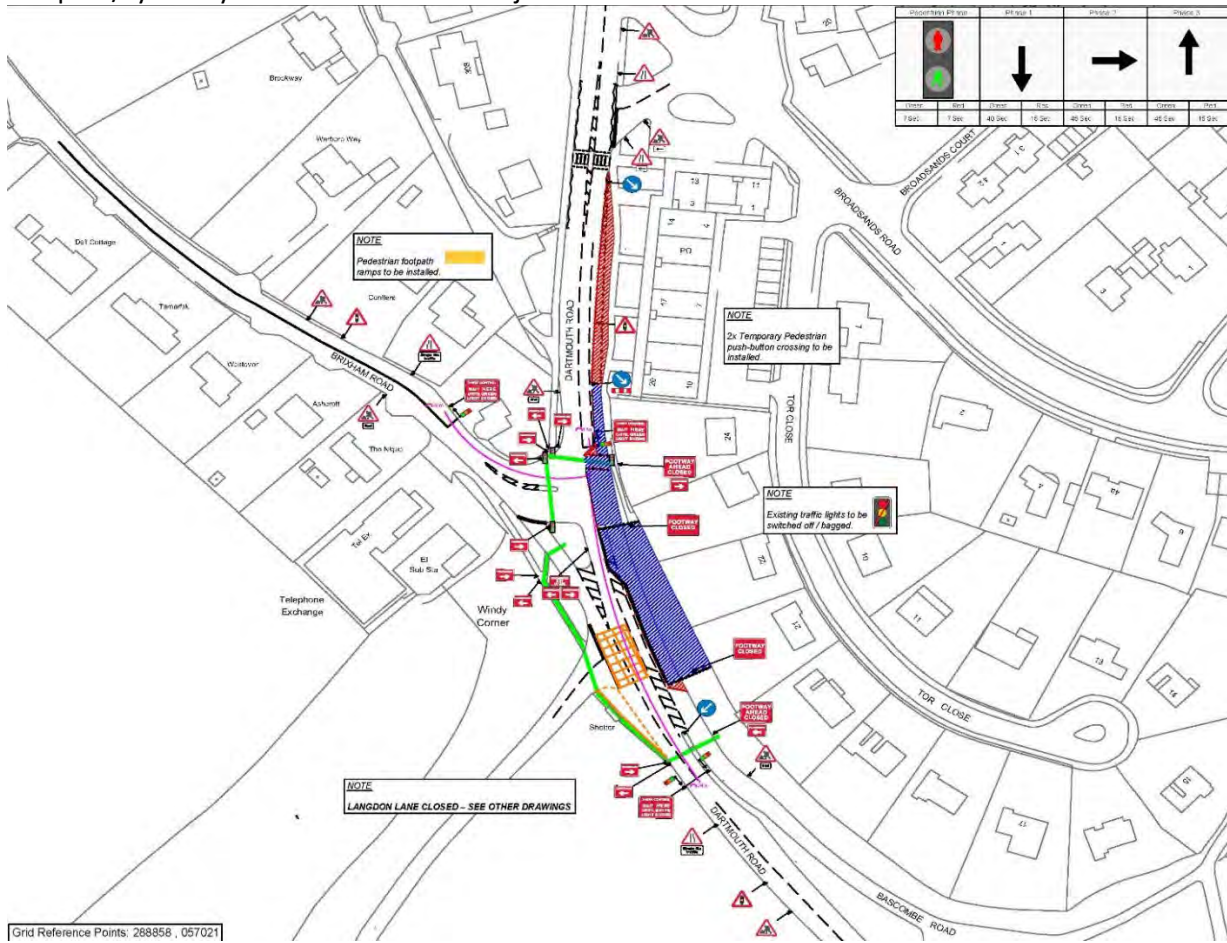
To help speed up traffic and minimise disruption, we confirm that the Langdon Road access to the A379 will be closed.

To respond to peak time traffic flows and optimise the traffic flows, the lights will be manned at all times from 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday. The temporary lights will unfortunately be slower by their nature than the permanent lights but we hope that by management we can minimise disruption.

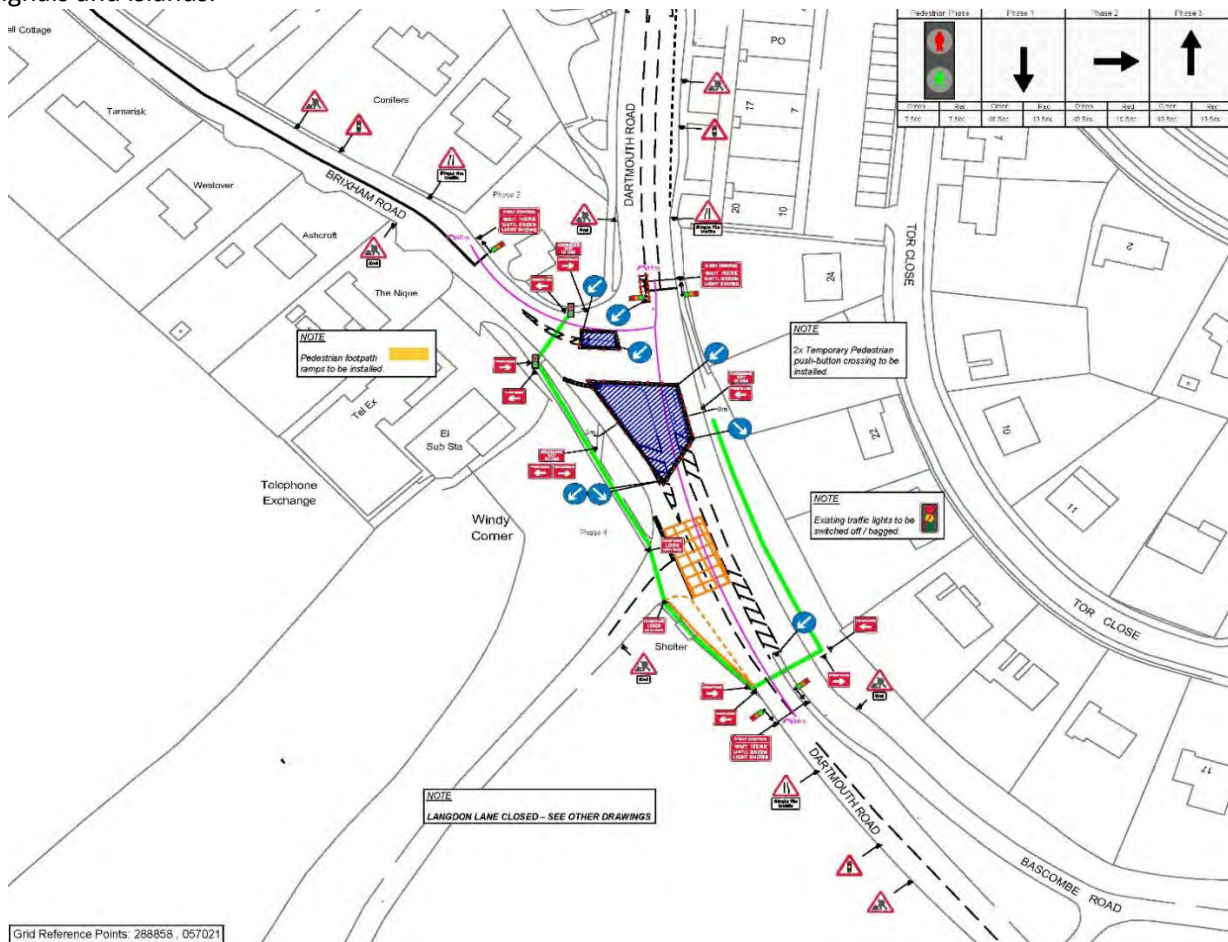
Plan 1201 below, will be the first activities to allow the traffic islands to be removed.



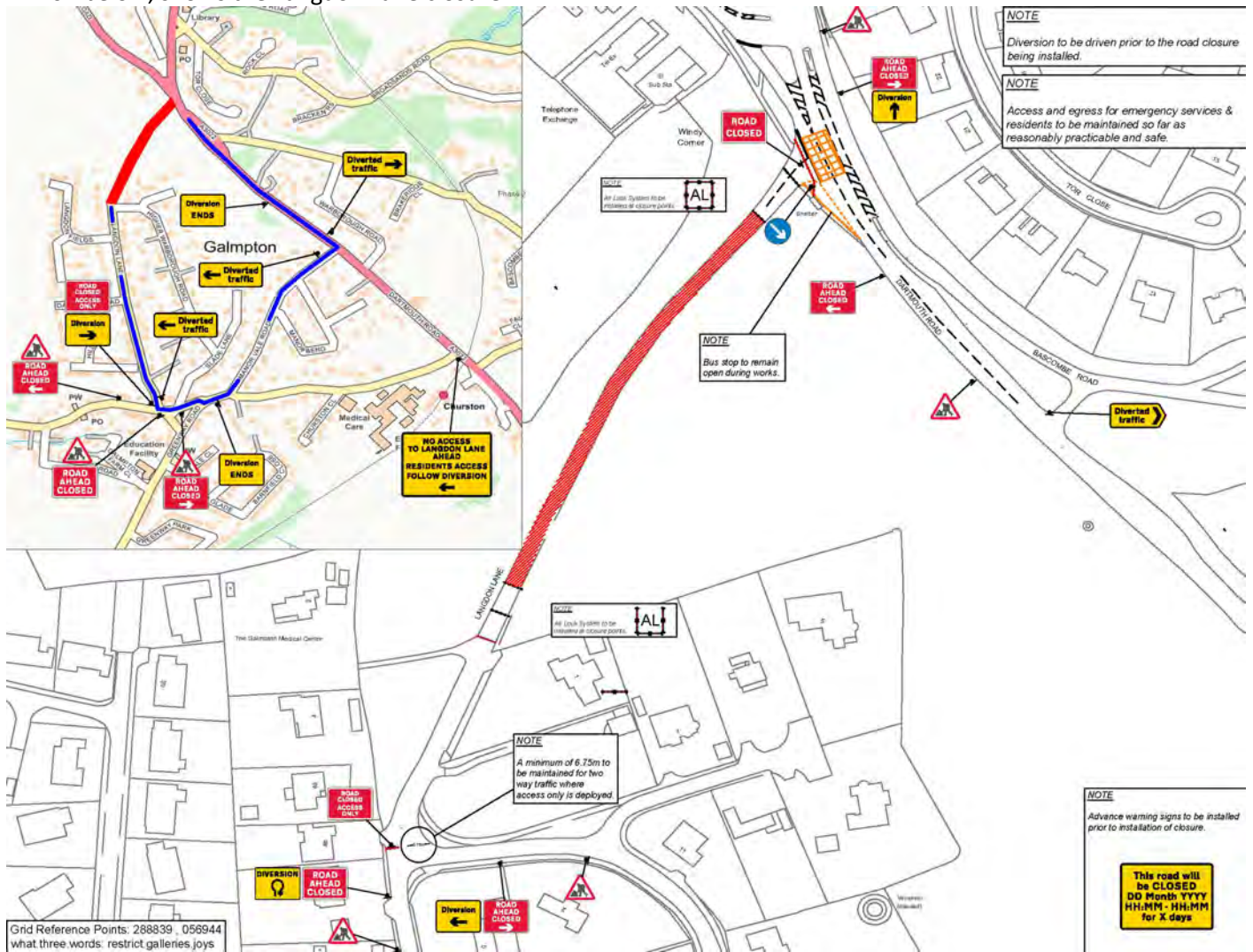
Plan 1202 below, will be second in the sequence of work to allow the retaining wall to be built allowing the footpath/cycleway to be widened and the junction amended.



Plan 1203 below, will be the third phase of work to allow the middle islands to be renewed and to complete the signals and islands.



Plan 1204 below, shows the Langdon Lane closure.



The works are quite dynamic, and the traffic signals and location of works may alter daily but always with the aim of minimising disruption to the traffic flows.

Footpath closures will be required but alternative routes will be available for pedestrians and cycles including some areas which may require cyclists to dismount due to restricted pavement widths.
