

## SOUTH HAMS DISTRICT COUNCIL REPORT FROM ROSEMARY ROWE.

We have not had any formal meetings of The Council since the last week in July at Follaton House. Most of Council Work during the summer period has been dealing with residents' problems. These seem to be with reference to Planning Applications, Enforcement Orders, Waste Collections and Street Cleaning to name a few. We are starting again from Mon.5<sup>th</sup> Sept. With lots to do.

Locality officers are covering The District and making regular checks on Council owned and operated toilets, Street Bin Collections' and Street Cleaning, Dog poo bins and generally checking up on almost anything which needs attention during this busy summer season.

On Wed.7<sup>th</sup> Sept. The D.M.Committee at their meeting will be considering a Planning Application to approve the change of use of part of The South Embankment to approve the continued use of nine pitches to be used by the hospitality businesses to provide outdoor seating for the serving of Food and drink. A condition of The Approval is for three years.

At the last Full Council Meeting in July a report was considered and agreed with a programme to install Solar Panels on The Fusion Leisure centres to assist with the energy supplies. The cost of running these is escalating via the cost of running the pools.

Dartmouth T.C. has been working hard to secure a bid for the Old Dartmouth Hospital Site.

The New H. & W. B .Building is progressing and there are going to be opportunities to visit the premises in the next few weeks.

The Port of Dartmouth Regatta was held recently. It was blessed with good weather and plenty of visitors.
