There is not an awful lot to report for the past month.

The main event which has happened is that The Council has taken the waste service management back to in house. All collection Lorries have been out each day .However if you have a missed collection please report it on line within two working days. The final brown Bin collections have taken place before the 1st of November .Any missed collections if reported through the system, either on line or by telephone will be sorted .Householders should have received a letter from S.H.D.C. giving all the information about the service which will start from The Spring of 2023. (Hopefully at the beginning of March)The charge for the service will be £49.00 for emptying the green waste. The service will be a fortnightly collection of The Brown Bin. This will be a yearly service with the exception of the Christmas period. Advance warning will be given to subscribers.

The system is now up and running to register for the brown bin collection service at a cost of £ 49.00 and those wishing to have the brown bin service must register before the 22nd January 2223
